

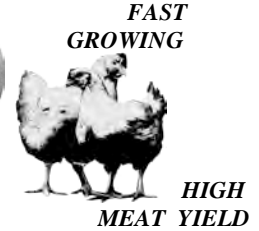

### Heavy White Cornish Cross Broiler: (Excellent for free range and pastured poultry operations)

We ourselves are using what we sell in our own varied farm operations; poussin, broiler, roaster, capons.

Broad breasted Cornish Cross that makes great fryers (broilers), and roasters. This is a high yield bird meant for heavier weights, which is still a fast growing breed, the difference is in the first week of growth it's a little slower than a broiler which gives the body time to build bone strength. Has excellent feed conversion, livability, strong legs and a maximum white meat yield with a plump full confirmation, that today's markets desire. At six to eight weeks of age, weights of 3 ½ lbs. - 5 lbs. processed weights, grow out time will achieve either lighter or heavier weights. With using a well-managed care and feeding program, customers have achieved processed weights of 10 - 14 lbs roasters and capons at 10 - 14 weeks. (Processed weights could vary from producer to producer depending on conditions of management, nutrition, and biological environments; weather and relief).

### Cornish - Poussin: (French for young chicken)

Use Heavy Cornish broiler 28 to 31 days *depending upon feed* will yield a processed 1 lb bird; 32 to 38 days 1 ¼ - 1 ½ lb. bird. Birds will have ample meat yield for body frame and that full packaged presentation needed for markets.

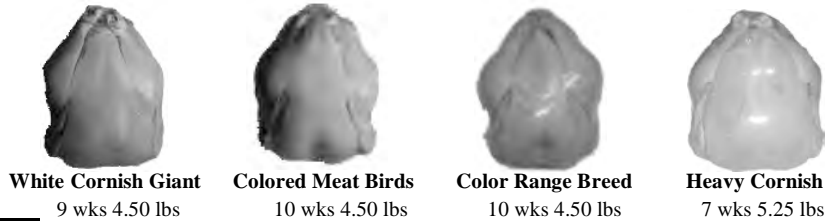
**What these birds will do** is forage, be active, and dust bath but most important put on ample meat weight. Slower growing breeds have a darker yellow fat compared to the pale yellow fat of the fast growing. Also breast bone, leg (drumstick) and wings are longer in length than the fast growing Cornish (see processed bird pictures next page).

**What these birds will not have** is that double breast meat and fast growth rate. If you want lots of breast meat then you need to get the Heavy Cornish Cross broilers, *this strain* will forage but not as aggressive as the slower growing birds.

\*\*\* Both the fast and the slower growing breeds are being used for Free Range, Full Pasturing, Natural, Organic, Backyard and Custom Live Markets. It's all in what you want to produce; all of the breeds offered are unique in their performance and taste.

**Processed birds:**

This will give you a good idea of how they will finish out. The difference is grow out time and overall confirmation slower growers will have longer wing span and legs. Breast bone is longer

**White Cornish (Rock) Giant & Meat Bird varieties:** Genetic stock derives from crossing White Cornish (Rock) Giant (non hybrid broiler strain) with several heritage breed genetics to attain a large meaty body frame for ample meat production and color feathering for ethnic markets

**White Cornish (Rock) Giant**

Alternative to the fast growing white broilers extremely hardy not a hybrid, finishes out exceptionally well large drumsticks & thighs white feathering, yellow feet.



**Gray Meat Bird:**

Grayish with barring to the feathering has exceptional flavor, maybe a dark or light gray depending on hatch.



**Red Cornish Meat Bird**

Easy dressing birds, females have a reddish outer feathering with a grayish under color, black tipped tail feathers. Males are a colorful variation of dark to light red body feathering some may have grey barring on tail, and wing, yellow feet. Exceptional meat flavor, one of the larger colored breeds.



**Kosher King:**

Developed for markets desiring a heavier meat yielding colored bird with stamina. Very popular with ethnic markets & growers for color & tasty meat qualities. Feathering resembles a Barred Rock, large body size yellow feet.



**Multi Color/ Striped Meat Bird:**

Each hatch is different thus the name multi colored, a beautiful large breed sometimes having a stripe (barred) design, 40% feathering whitish gray with a mix of varied light and dark shades of black, red, tan and gray feathering. Very popular with ethnic markets a unique choice to grow with having a quality taste.



**Black Meat Bird:**

Excellent tasting, males are mostly all black with some having scarlet tinted feathers around neck and back, black feet. Females are black with black feet.

**Red Sex Link** (Buff, Golden Comet) a hybrid **brown egg** layer having a calm disposition and high egg yielding qualities that is perfect for any size flock. Females are medium red weighing at maturity 4 lbs, males are white with darker wing neck and tail feathers 5 to 6 lbs.

**Leghorn** Excellent **white egg** layer, body weight 3.60 to 3.80 lbs

**Black Sex Link** (Blk Star, Shaver Blk) a hybrid, superb **brown egg** layer, females are black with a gold breast; males barred black and white 5 to 5.5 lb.

**R.I. Reds** are a popular superior egg laying dual-purpose breed, which is a deep red color with a calm manner. Mature weights of 7.5 to 6.5 lbs.

### Fancy Breeds

**Silver Laced Wyandotte** are a heavy docile bird with a rose comb feathering is silvery white edged in greenish black, a very hardy and colorful productive bird that is a pleasure to have around.

**Golden Laced Wyandotte** an exquisite brown egg layer, rose combed with majestic goldish brown feathers laced in a shiny green-black edging.

**Lt. Brown Leghorn** excellent white egg layers, feathers are multi colored shades of brown, which truly help protect them from predators if free ranging. Males have greenish colored tail feathers and on the lower body parts, a very colorful bird to have in a flock.

**Buff Orpingtons** golden color with a quiet disposition, heavy plumage makes them excellent winter layers. This breed is also broody.

**California Grey Leghorn** large chalk white eggs. Feathering is white with a few black flecks, very gentle nature.

**Araucana/Americana** colored eggs in shades of olive green to a medium blue, also offered in the bantams.

**Delaware** a dual-purpose breed, lays large brown eggs avg. # males 8 1/2 lb. Hens 6 1/2 lb. beautiful birds are mostly white with neck and tail feathers having striped black bars.

**Speckled Sussex** light brown eggs, rich mahogany plumage with individual feathers ending in white tips separated by feathers with black barring.

**Turken**  Originated in Europe nick named Naked Neck for its Turkey-like bare neck, despite the lack of feathering on the body it holds up to cold weather. Sure to add an oddity to the flock, raise for meat eggs or fun.

**Blue Andalusian** are a slate gray edged with black lines offspring may turn out to be black and blue or black splashes as well the blue color. Lay large white eggs, avg. # males 7 lb. Hens 5 1/2 lb.

**Dark Cornish** are unique because of their thick, compact bodies, unusually wide backs, and broad, deep breasts. Known for their great meat qualities. Pea combed and lays small brown eggs.

**Light Brahma** a very old brown egg laying breed from Asia. Traits include massive size, a gentle disposition with full feathered shanks & toes, striking black and white plumage and pea comb.

**Delaware x New Hampshire** (Indian River) another dual-purpose cross that is used for meat and brown eggs.

**Columbian Wyandotte**  a wonderful unusual light to rich brown egg layer from the Wyandotte breeding that will add pleasure to any flock. Rose combed.

**Jersey Black Giant** a massive bird in appearance lays large brown eggs. Black with a green sheen, straight red comb, known for persistence of laying through cold weather.

**Dominique** a beautiful rose combed breed that lays medium brown eggs resembles, a Barred Rock, an old rare breed.

**Ancona** referred to as the Mottled Leghorn, closely related to the leghorn. Good foragers and with having darker feathering make them less likely to be picked off by birds of prey. Large white eggs

**Partridge Rocks** a dual-purpose breed, lays a smaller size brown egg avg. # males 9 1/2 lb. Hens 7 1/2 lb.

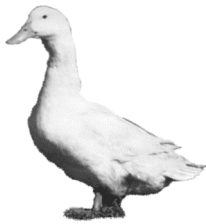

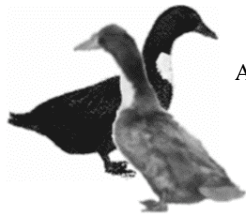

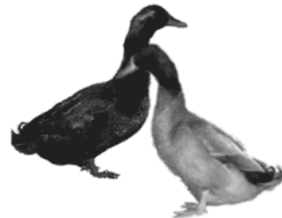

**White Pekins** All white with orange feet and bill, fast growing for meat production, males 10-11 lbs. females 8 to 9 lbs., excellent layers.

**Mallards** Will fly unless one wing is clipped, hardy and great foragers. Used primarily as ornamental duck or regulated hunting grounds.

**Rouen** Similar to a Pekin for meat production, Drakes 8-9 lbs. Duck 6 to 7 lbs., but colored like a Mallard Ducks (will not fly)

**Khaki Campbell** Colorful feathering from light beige to brown with green bills, males have a darker brown head. Great for meat and eggs (lays eggs like a chicken). Average mature weights males 4.5 lbs., females 4 lbs.

**Blue Swedish** Swedish Ducks are becoming increasingly popular because of their hardiness to the cold and ability to adapt. They have an excellent feed conversion and fatten easily for eating. The Blue Swedish is a beautiful gray-bluish slate color with some feathers shaded slightly darker. They also have some white feathering on their breast and wings. Producers of large amounts of bluish to gray-white eggs, Drakes 8 lbs., Duck 7 lbs. (smaller compared to the Pekin, and Rouen)

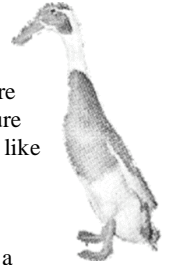

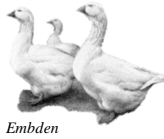

## Care of Baby Poultry: chickens, ducks, geese and guineas

REMEMBER ANYONE HANDLING BIRDS OR ANIMALS SHOULD THOROUGHLY WASH THEIR HANDS AFTERWARDS.

\*\* Should have a draft free clean pen with fresh water and new feed. When baby poultry arrives to you give water first then set out the feed. **Guinea Keets give warm fresh water upon arrival.** A one foot high chick guard should be used around chicks brooding area to keep them near the heat source and to stop any drafts, it can be taken away after 10 days. Baby poultry need 90 to 95 degrees for the first week, and then lower the temperature by 5 degrees each week. A brooder lamp (heat bulb) 4 bulb, 250-watt is sufficient for 300 chicks; lesser amounts can be brooded with a single lamp. **Watch the behavior of the young poultry to determine if it's warm enough. When cold they will be loud and huddle close together, if comfortable they will be reasonably quiet and will be eating, drinking or sleeping.** Two 1-gallon waters and two 24-inch feeders per 100 chicks when they are little and then use larger waters and feed containers as they get older. When weather permits and the young poultry are old enough you can let them outside.

\*\* Use 2 to 4 inches of **dry litter**, such as pine wood shavings, chopped straw or other appropriate bedding. **Do not use newspaper or other slick material**, this can cause legs to slip out from underneath them and cause serious leg problems. Do not use bedding such as cedar chips, treated shavings, large thick wood chips or dusty sawdust.

\*\* Use a good starter feed, (**ask your local feed dealers**) then a grower feed. **Guinea keets cannot eat a coarse feed therefore should be fed a very fine crumbled feed or mash.** Granite grit helps their digestive system for meat birds, calcium grit for layers when ready to lay eggs.

### Special care of baby ducks & geese

\*\* **Feed:** Use a well balanced Non-Medicated Feed, **medicated feed used for chicks and turkeys will kill goslings and ducklings (ask your local feed dealer what's available)** starter crumbs for 3 to 4 weeks, then grower pellets. Most water fowl also like green grass.

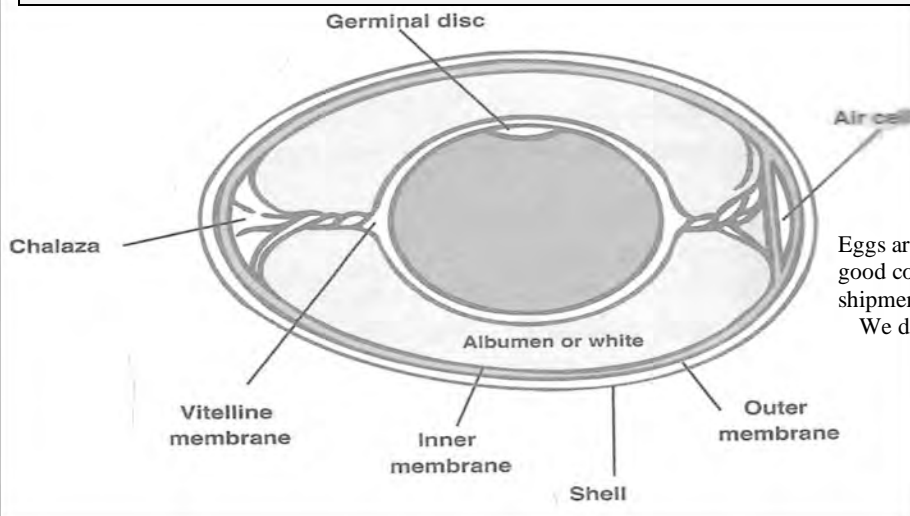
\*\* **Health:** Access to drinking water at all time, but not enough to swim in. Since they were not hatched by their mother they do not have her protective oil on their down to repel water and can only swim for short periods of time until they start to sink. Also ducklings and goslings do not get their feathers until they are four or five weeks old, meaning, they shouldn't be left outside in the cold or rainy weather.

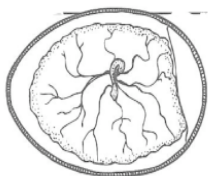

## What is a Capon?

Capons are considered to be the ultimate choice in poultry meats. A delicacy that's truly valued by chefs and food concur's a like for it's a juicy, tender, and succulent flavor. Capons will also **bring a higher market value**. A capon is a male chicken that has been surgically desexed at an early age. After being caponized the chicken (capon) becomes quiet and docile, which slows down the muscling process making dark & white meat muscles soft (*not tough or stringy*). This readily makes the bird plump evenly giving it the distinguished juicy and tender flavorful meat qualities. A capon will mature in 10 to 14 weeks, weighing 9 to 13 pounds dressed weight.

## Capon Raising Tips

- ◆ Allow two to three square feet per bird.
- ◆ Two inches of dry litter, adding to a total of three inches as birds grow, if confined.
- ◆ Ranged birds shouldn't be kept where predators have access to your flock.
- ❖ **Restrictive Feeding:** Feed a sufficient amount for every bird to be full at each feeding in the morning and then evening. This will increase their growing time. Some growers like to feed this way but we feel it's not required due to the hearty type of breed we're using (high yield Cornish Cross).
- ❖ **Full Feed:** Having feed all the time, this will shorten growing time.
- ❖ Capons are lazy don't feed extra corn, birds will get fat
- ❖ Supply with clean fresh water. Can give a vitamin, mineral supplement, we recommend one with a higher AD3 & E Mineral level. (D and E are for strengthening bones).
- ❖ Use granite grit with mash type feed, not required with pellets.
- ❖ Commercial chick starter feed (medicated) for 1 to 2 weeks after you receive the birds, 18 to 21% protein.
- ❖ Grower, or meat developer feed, 14% to 16% protein
- ❖ If birds are getting too heavy or fat, feed 20% whole oats per 100 pounds of feed. If needed you can increase % of oats.

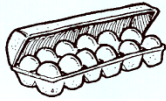

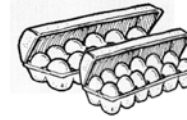
