High Yield Broad Breasted Cornish Cross breed that makes great fryers (broilers) and roasters because of the weights that can be achieved. This breed has an excellent feed conversion, livability, strong legs, and a maximum white meat yield with a plump full confirmation. At 6 to 8 weeks of age processed weights of 4 ½ to 6 lbs. can be obtained. Higher weights can be obtained depending on the final grow out duration. With using a well-managed care and feeding program, customers have achieved processed weights of 10 to 14 lb. roasters and capons within 10 to 14 weeks. This breed is also use for Cornish-Poussins (French for young chicken) 28 to 31 days will yield a processed 1 to 1 ¼ lb. bird; 32 to 38 days 1 ½ to 2 lb. bird

Colored Meat Birds & Color Range Breeds

Performance traits include increased foraging activity, a greater resistance to disease, livability, strong legs, and excellent feed conversion. All alternative breeds will have a longer breast bone, legs (drumstick), and wing span. They will also have a darker yellow fat compared to the pale yellow fat of the fast growing breeds. What these birds will not have is that double breast meat and fast growth rate which they make up for in other benefits. We offer several different breeds with different growth rates.

ALTERNATIVE BROILERS

Food enthusiasts looking for an active robust breed that has a tender delicious flavorful meat other than the fast-growing white broilers or slow-growing heritage dual purpose breeds can order any of the broilers below and they will work well for you.

RED CORNISH: Are excellent foragers for free range that grows at a moderate rate achieving live weights of approximately 5.4 lbs. in 9 weeks on 12.5 pounds of feed. This breed has a longer breast/keel bone and has a more proportioned white to dark meat yield to its body

ROYAL: Similar to the Regal Broiler but has a shorter breast/keel bone and larger breast portions to smaller leg and thigh portions. Live weight 5.75 lbs. 9 weeks on approximately 13.5 lbs. of feed.

<u>White Pekins</u> white with orange feet & bill, fast growing for meat production, 7.5–13.5 lbs.

<u>Jumbo Pekins</u> are like the Pekin but were breed for size and meat production. Are highly fertile with good egg production when kept on a diet to produce eggs. 9.5 lbs. female-11 lbs. male



<u>Muscovy</u> have excellent meat production and have a leaner meat than Pekins. As adults the males are twice the size of females and have large beefy breast meat. They can fly and are excellent foragers eating large amounts of grass compared to other breeds. *Location in Ephrata, PA for a local pick up of large orders (when available) hatches are not weekly. Call for details

<u>Rouen</u> Similar to a Pekin for meat, Drakes 8-9 lbs. Duck 6 to 7 lbs., but colored like a Mallard Ducks

Khaki Campbell Colorful from light beige to brown with green bills, males have darker brown heads. Dual purpose meat and eggs, lays eggs like a chicken. Avg weights male 4.5 lbs. females 4 lbs.

White Layer & Golden Layer Lay more and larger eggs than the Khaki Campbell duck and have a calmer temperament with a higher fertility 4.5-5.75 lbs. Call for details.

<u>Mallards</u> Will fly unless one wing is clipped, hardy and great foragers. Used primarily for ornamental or regulated hunting grounds.

Indian Runner

Fawn & White, Black, Blue & Chocolate

Nicknamed Penguin Duck, long slender bodies with upright posture. The vertical posture allows them to run very quickly instead of waddling like other ducks. Runners' eggs are white with a tint of green or blue.

<u>Cayuga</u> A cold hardy duck, medium to large in size with a metallic green sheen on feathers, Drake 8 lbs. Duck 7 lbs. Egg color is ebony black.

<u>Buff Duck</u> (Buff Orpington) dual purpose breed for eggs & meat.

<u>Blue Swedish</u> gray-bluish slate color with some feathers shaded slightly darker, white feathering on their breast and wings. Bluish to gray-white eggs, 7 - 8 lbs., Cold Hardy <u>Black Swedish</u> Similar to the Blue, but black in color with the white feathering on their breast and wings.

<u>Crested Ducks</u> a unique breed with tufts of feathers on head, available in White sometimes Blue Swedish





CARE OF BABY POULTRY:

CHICKENS, DUCKS, GEEESE and GUINEAS



ARRIVAL DATE be sure to have some flexible time to pick up your poultry at the post office, sometimes they do not arrive when expected due to reasons we cannot control such as hatching and shipping delays.

WATCH THE BEHAVIOR to determine if it's warm enough. When cold they will be loud and huddle close together, if comfortable they will be reasonably quiet and will be eating, drinking or sleeping.

BEDDING use 2 to 4 inches of **dry litter**, such as pine wood shavings, chopped straw or other appropriate bedding, **do not use newspaper or other slick material**, this can cause legs to slip out from underneath them and cause serious leg problems. **Do not use** bedding such as cedar chips, treated shavings, large thick wood chips or dusty sawdust.

FIRST DAY INSTRUCTIONS have a clean draft free pen with fresh water and new feed. When baby poultry arrives <u>make sure they drink water</u> then give them feed. *Guinea Keets need to have room temperature water upon arrival and smash their feed to be smaller for the first couple days.* A one foot high chick guard should be used around chicks brooding area to keep them near the heat source and stop any drafts, it can be taken away after 10 days.

TEMPERATURE for the first week at chick height should be 90-95 degrees. Decrease the temperature 5 degrees per week until temperature of 65 is reached. Turkeys and pheasants start 5 degrees higher. A brooder lamp (heat bulb) 4 bulb, 250-watt is sufficient for 300 chicks; lesser amounts can be brooded with a single lamp.

FEED & WATER Use a good starter feed, (local feed dealer) then switch to a grower feed. Two 1-gallon waters and two 24-inch feeders per 100 chicks when they are little and then use larger waters and feed containers as they get older. When weather permits and the young poultry are old enough you can let them outside. Granite grit helps their digestive system for meat birds, calcium grit for layers when ready to lay eggs.

Feed: Use a well-balanced Non-Medicated Feed, medicated Chick/turkey feed will kill goslings & ducklings (ask your feed dealer what's available) starter crumbs for 3-4 weeks, then grower pellets. Water fowl also like green grass, start them slowly on grass don't let them over do it.

Health: Access to drinking water at all time, and since they weren't hatched by their mother they don't have her protective oil on their down to repel water and can only swim for short periods of time until they start to sink. They do not get their feathers until they are 4 or 5 weeks old, meaning they shouldn't be left outside in the cold or rainy weather.
