**What percentage of protein should I feed
my meat birds?**

Meat chicks grow best when fed 23% protein for the first 10 days, then 21% protein from day 11 to day 24. After day 25, an 18% protein feed provides what they need until market weight. If these birds are not fed enough protein early on, they will not fill out properly.

Red Sasso

Minimum 15 chicks per order.

A slower-growing alternative to the Cornish Cross, this bird is ideal for specialty markets and smaller operations. Their manageable size and natural growing schedule make them highly suitable for pasture-based systems. Alternative broilers are well-known for their rich, high-quality meat. Although they have darker feathers than white broilers, this breed plucks well for easy processing.

Growers can expect a conversion rate of 2.5 to 2.8 between 9 to 11 weeks of age. The Red Sasso can achieve a live weight of 5 to 6.25 lbs between 9 to 11 weeks.

It can also be kept for eggs, laying around 200-280 large brown eggs per year.

Post Office Pickup

Notify your post office that you are expecting live animals. Your post office will call you when your birds arrive. Upon pickup, protect your chicks from drastic fluctuations in temperature (no direct air conditioning or heat) and ensure they are kept out of direct sunlight. Put your chicks in the brooder as soon as you arrive home.

Water

Chicks need to hydrate after arrival. Teach your chicks how to drink by gently dipping their beaks into room temperature water. Ensure that your waterer is shallow or filled with rocks to prevent drowning. Adjust the waterer height for your chicks as they grow.

Bedding

We recommend 2-4 inches of pine shavings. Other options like newspaper, sawdust, or cedar are harmful to your chicks. Make sure your pine shavings are dry and free of mold before use.

Warmth

Infrared heat lamps are ideal. Keep your chicks at a steady 90-95 degrees for week one. Use a thermometer to check the temperature at floor level. Lower the temperature by approximately 5 degrees each week until your chicks are 6 weeks old, at which point you can start weaning them off external heat.

Brooder Space

Set up your brooder prior to arrival. Your brooder and brooder area should be dry, pest-free, and draft-free. Ensure that the brooder as well as your enclosure have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected prior to chick arrival.

Feed

Use a chick starter feed that is compatible with your type of bird. We recommend medicated feed if you choose not to vaccinate your chicks against Coccidiosis. Make sure food and water is plentiful and not directly under the heat source.
